Our Priorities

Use of allocated participatory budget in consultation with all stakeholders

Develop a pupil group to inform the wider school community of Cost of the School Day and allocate Participatory Budget effectively.

Reduce the Cost of the School day for all families

Create a school equity strategy paper, which highlights rationale and approaches for Cost of the School Day

Increase confidence and engagement through outdoor learning activities

Run outdoor learning activities with targeted learners.

Use targeted interventions to raise attainment in literacy and numeracy

Fund additional class teacher to run targeted intervention with targeted learners.

Increase engagement and leadership possibilities for targeted learners

Identified learners participating in Young Leaders of Learning programme. Observe, evaluate and give feedback to support school improvement and give authentic pupil voice.

Promote positive wellbeing, relationships and self-esteem through nurture.

Implement small nurture groups that provide a safe and supportive environment where pupils can build confidence and develop positive relationships.
