What's on offer?



Family Learning Activity	Description of the Session
Sharing the Learning	These sessions will run 3x per year and are an opportunity for your child to teach their families about how they learn literacy, numeracy and health and wellbeing at their stage.
Inclusion - Nibbles and Natters	An informal opportunity for parents/carers with a child with any additional support need to come together in a supportive space. The informal sessions will be shaped by what parents/carers would find useful and could be discussion, support sessions or feedback on what day to day activities, events or approaches that impact your child, letting us know how to best support learners in our school community.
Health and Wellbeing Hub Drop In	Our HWB Hub is a friendly, informal space where you can drop in to: chat about your child's HWB needs, ask questions about school approaches, get practical tips and signposting to supports, share your ideas on how to improve our HWB network. No appointment needed – just come along for a chat!
Stay and Play	An opportunity for P1 parents to play alongside your child in their classroom learning environment.
Community Events	One of the benefits of the collaborative leadership model is we can provide an enhanced provision for family learning workshops where these are not tailored specifically to the curriculum designed for Springfield or Low Port e.g. digital tools to support learning or Languages evening. These may be delivered at either school.
Curriculum Café @ Parents' Evening	Support stations will be set up in the gym hall offering parent/carers a range of advice and information. The focus will be decided following feedback from our parent body.

Playground Development	An opportunity to discuss and organise how to develop our playground area for play and learning.
Cost of the School Day / Equity	This group will work together to find ways to reduce the cost of the school day, while enhancing inclusion, fairness, and a sense of belonging for every family in our community.
