Our Priorities

Further deepen staff and family understanding of the impact of the COSD.
Promote supports for COSD with pupils, parents and staff consistently.
Consult all stakeholders on newly created school equity strategy paper, which highlights rationale and approaches to reduce the COSD.

To further develop effective differentiation in class, to enable effective challenge and support

Staff participation in the Leaders of Learning WLC programme.
SfL input to support with in class team teaching opportunities; planning support; advice and consultation around inclusive practice in class, including use of digital tools.

Use targeted interventions to raise attainment in Literacy and Numeracy

SfL and PSW intervention groups to support Literacy and Numeracy with targeted learners.
Collaboration with the Language and Literacy Support Service to further build staff capacity.
Effective assessment in Literacy and Numeracy to identify next steps.

To increase pupil confidence, self-esteem and sense of belonging through leadership opportunities.

Identified learners continued participation in the 'Young Leaders of Learning' programme, leading training of new pupil members.
Observe, evaluate and give feedback to support school improvement and provide authentic pupil voice.
